### We have had a nice

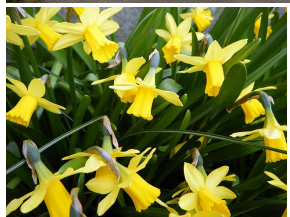
start to the New Year with a lot of new members joining us on our runs.
